



Possible Outcomes on the Totality of Qualifications Assessment (July 2021)

“Totality” of the educational qualifications is defined as the integrated learning outcomes of the qualification including those learning outcomes achieved through learning deemed to have a substantial bearing on the qualification under assessment.
